During the last year our Children and Youth have participated in a variety of activities. The L.O.G. (Lamb of God) Bells and choir presented music for Rally Day. In September and October, the Children and Youth worked on bird feeders to donate to the Harvest Day Sale. We prepared and presented a music program for the residents of Brookdale Senior Living Community and had a wonderful evening of Trunk-or-Treat. 
